

Hoops for a Cause 3v3 Tournament

Game Format & Rules

1. Games will be played on 1 basket on 1 half-court
2. Rock-Paper-Scissors will determine possession at the start of the game.
3. Each game will be to 20 points or 15 minutes long.
4. Teams score by a regular two point basket.
5. Teams are responsible for keeping track of the score throughout the game. The score should be announced prior to every checking of the ball. The winning team shall report the score to the court supervisor. In the event of a score discrepancy, teams shall restart the game from the last agreed upon score.
6. After a made basket, the team that was on defense will start at the top of the key on offense. There is no make-it-take-it.
7. Teams must take a ball back past the "check line" after each change of possession. The check line shall be past an imaginary line running across the top of the 3-point line, from sideline to sideline.
8. Stalling or failing to play actively (i.e. not attempting to score) shall be a violation which will result in a turnover.
9. A minimum of three players are required to be present at the start of the scheduled start time, teams are allowed to have 4 players on the roster.
10. Only players who are listed on a team's roster form may play. No alternate or pick-up players will be allowed.
11. Fouls will be called by the players on the court. A defensive foul on a made basket shall result in the basket counting and the fouling team starting with the ball at the top of the key. A common foul, or a foul resulting in a missed shot, shall result in the fouled team starting with the ball at the top of the key. There will be no free throws. The court supervisors have the right to issue warnings or disqualify teams from the tournament if teams continually foul their opponents.
12. Substitutions may be made after a basket or an out of bounds play.
13. Each team will be allotted one 30 second time out.
14. If the game ends in a tie after time has expired, there will be a one minute overtime period.
15. All participants must use appropriate language and display good sportsmanship. If any behavior departs from this standard, your team will be eliminated from the tournament.
