Bourne Together 2020

Welcome to the Bourne Together program, where our priority is the safety and well-being of your children. This Summer will look a lot different in the Rec Department due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, but we are happy to be back even in a limited setting. Below is a list of some quick facts that may answer some questions you have about the program this summer.

- Due to the restrictions set by the EEC, we are limited to 8 children per session per day.
- As many games as possible will be played outside where children can safely social distance.
- During rainy days, games can be played inside the gym maintaining social distancing.
- Sign in will be contactless, and conducted outside of Room 1.
- A verbal and visual screening will be conducted before your child can enter the building.
- All screening records will be kept private and stored in your child's file.
- Visitors will not be allowed to enter the building.
- All activities have been designed to minimize the sharing of equipment.
- Staff will be encouraged to wear a mask throughout the program.
- Children must wear masks when social distancing isn't possible.
- Room 1 will be considered the "base" of the program. Tables will be set 6 ft apart from each
 other, and children will be assigned a seat. Symbols will correlate with their own bin which will
 hold all items they brought to the program.
- Sign out will be contactless, and held behind the Community Building outside the Veteran Lobby Doors.
- The Community Center will be cleaned regularly and disinfected at the end of each session.
- Protocols pertaining to First Aid/CPR will be reviewed by the Bourne Fire Department prior to the start of the program.
